 <b>LIBERTY</b> FREEDOM ORDERED TOWARD GOD'S TRUTH	 <b>LICENSE</b> FREEDOM DETACHED FROM TRUTH AND RESTRAINT
 <b>FREEDOM UNDER GOD</b> Freedom is exercised within the boundaries of God's moral law.	 <b>FREEDOM WITHOUT RESTRAINT</b> Desire becomes the only authority; limits are rejected.
 <b>OBEDIENCE TO TRUTH</b> Truth defines what is good, right, and life-giving.	 <b>INDULGENCE OF THE FLESH</b> Passions rule behavior rather than wisdom or virtue.
 <b>SERVICE TO OTHERS</b> Freedom is used to bless, protect, and uplift neighbors.	 <b>SELF-CENTEREDNESS</b> The self becomes the highest priority, often at others' expense.
 <b>SELF-CONTROL</b> The will is disciplined; desires are governed by virtue.	 <b>MORAL CHAOS</b> Without shared truth and virtue, confusion, conflict, and division prevail.
 <b>RIGHTEOUSNESS</b> Choices align with God's standards, producing justice and stability.	 <b>NATIONAL DECLINE</b> When license spreads, families weaken, institutions crumble, and liberty is lost.
